

ESG Student Consultation 18th-22th August 2025 in Bremen

Are you interested in climate justice, international exchange, and making a difference?

Then join the ESG Student Consultation 2025! Together with students from Ghana and Germany, you will explore the upcoming UN Climate Conference (COP30) and develop your own ideas and perspectives on the climate crisis.

Who we are

The consultation is a joint project by the [ESG Bremen](#) (Evangelische Studierenden Gemeinde), the [Evangelical Presbyterian Students' Union](#) of the University of Ghana in Accra (EPSU) and the [Norddeutsche Mission](#) (NM). Six members of the EPSU who study at the University of Ghana in Accra will be joining the consultation together with their youth pastor Reverend Courage Paemka. We also hope for several participants from Bremen, Oldenburg and Lippe to achieve a group size of around 14 people in total.

Learn about climate justice and make your voice heard

Core goal of the program is to dive into issues of climate justice and COP30 together while exchanging diverse perspectives. To amplify your voices, we will produce short video interviews in which you and your peers can share your views, hopes, and demands related to COP30. These clips are intended to be shared on social media and used as educational material in future events.

Benefits

- Get to know committed students from Ghana and Germany, learn from each other, and gain new perspectives on global challenges and climate action.
- This will be a great preparation in case you want to join the next student consultation 2027 in Ghana.
- You will receive participation certificates to add to your CV.
- Learn about the work of the NM, ESG and EPSU.
- All this will be free of charge, including meals and accommodation (if you are from Bremen, you will sleep at your own place, if you are joining from another city, there is a guest flat of the NM).

The program consists of three phases:

1. **Online preparation (July 2025)**
In an interactive online seminar, you will get to know the organizers and fellow participants. Together, you will discuss the plans for the main event and decide which specific climate-related topics you want to focus on. You will also connect in small groups to prepare inputs for the consultation in August.
2. **Main event in Bremen (August 18–22, 2025)**
During this one-week in-person event, you will meet climate activists, visit local sustainability projects, and give short video-interviews based on the ideas developed during the seminar.
3. **Final event (late November/ December 2025)**
After COP30 has taken place, we will finish the project with an online closing event. A guest expert who attended COP30 – such as Sabine Minninger from Brot für die Welt – will share insights into the negotiations. Together, we will critically reflect on the outcomes of the conference and their significance, especially for countries in the Global South.

All parts of the program will be held in English.
